


AUDIOGUIDE IN GRENOBLE

Access to free city maps at the tourism office; it gives you the chance to easily wander in the historic center and to discover the main monuments.



GRENOBLE AND BASTILLE

THE HISTORIC CENTER

1 TO 2 HOURS

This stroll around the historic center offers a great journey in the marvelous History of Grenoble, 2000 years old. A town where the knight Bayard survived, the Duke of Lesdiguières, Aristide Bergès, Marie Reynoard... Historic monuments and old dwellings can be seen with the old parliament palace, the cathedral, or else Stendhal's house.

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GRENOBLE BY BUS

1 HOUR

Discover the city by bus. A peaceful and comfortable trip but also highly rich as it shows different aspects of Grenoble: chic neighborhoods from the 19th century and elegant squares 'Victor Hugo and de Verdun', the big Paul Mistral Park, the three towers, the stadium 'Stade des Alpes'...

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GRENOBLE BY LITTLE RACK-RAILWAY

45 MIN TO 1 HOUR

Get yourself into a complete tour of the city center thanks to the little rack-railway. It brings you on the edge of the Isère River, pedestrian streets, in front of pavement sitting areas, fountains...

A stroll punctuated by historic comments to enjoy the secret charm of Grenoble.


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A 360° VIEW ON THE ALPS FROM THE BASTILLE

30 MIN TO 90 MIN

To reach the top of the Bastille, you only need 5 minutes with "bubbles": the cable car that brings you on top of the fortress. Up there, the touristic guide will comment on a unique show upon the city and the Alps until "Le Mont-Blanc". The mountain ranges surrounding Grenoble: Belledune, Chartreuse, and Vercors offer all very different landscapes between wild and rocky outlines, and forest softness.

MUSEUMS

MASTERPIECES MUSÉE DE GRENOBLE

90 MIN TO 2 HOURS

In an admirable and contemporary architecture, 'Musée de Grenoble' offers prestigious collections of occidental Art from 13th century until now. Works of art from Rubens, Ingres, Gauguin, Monet, Modigliani, Chagall, Matisse... The Museum also displays Egyptian antiquities.

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THE OLD NECROPOLIS AND ITS CRYPT MUSÉE ARCHÉOLOGIQUE

90 MIN TO 2 HOURS

In the old church of Saint-Laurent, the archeological site from the 4th to the 19th century, thanks to incredible lighting we are plunged into the History of funeral rites, everything is in a beautiful staging. The site reveals the crypt 'Saint-Oyand', testifying from the Early Middle Ages with its sculpted colonnade.

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THE RESISTANCE IN GRENOBLE MUSÉE DE LA RÉSISTANCE ET DE LA DÉPORTATION GRENOBLE

90 MIN TO 2 HOURS

The museum shows events of the Second World War from local History. Particularly the occupation from the German and Italian people, and in the Isere area. It displays the crucial role from the French Resistance as well as Women and Men that fight for the freedom of the country.

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PEOPLE OF THE ALP AND THE WHITE DREAM MUSÉE DAUPHINOIS GRENOBLE

2 HOURS

Three thousand years ago, people got set in the Alps. They faced altitude, slope, cold and isolation. At the end of the 19th century, ski infiltrates the French Alps. From there, everything moves faster: the useful ski is turning into Winter Sports. Let yourself be guided through 2 permanent exhibitions at the museum: one is testifying from the life and traditions in mountain pastures from the Dauphinois region at the end of the 19th century and one is telling us about the development and the evolution of Winter Sports in the Alps.

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IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF STENDHAL MUSEE STENDHAL GRENOBLE

1 HOUR LONG

The apartment of Doctor Gagnon, Stendhal's maternal grandfather, is the real family house where the heart and mind of the becoming writer, have been stimulated. This museum space recounts the childhood of one of the greatest French writer from the 19th century.

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MUSÉE DE LA RÉVOLUTION FRANÇAISE VIZILLE

1 H 30

1788, General Estates from the Dauphiné region gather together in the castle of Vizille. The French revolution is now on. The museum, settled in the castle, displays the French Revolution through the Arts.

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THE HISTORY OF MOUNTAIN TROOPS MUSÉE DES TROUPES DE MONTAGNE GRENOBLE

90 MIN

This museum is settled upon the fortress of the Bastille. It offers a poignant immersion, through a realistic scenography where sounds and lights mix in the world of soldiers since the beginning in the mountain.

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MUSÉE HECTOR BERLIOZ CÔTE SAINT-ANDRÉ

Settled in the native house from the composer, the museum displays an important collection mentioning Hector Berlioz: family life, links to the world of music, journeys and concerts through Europe...



INCREDIBLE DISCOVERIES



GRENOBLE BY SEGWAY

1H30/ 10 PERSONS MAXIMUM

Discover Grenoble in an incredible way thanks to gyropod-Segway! An electric engine with two stable wheels, with which one can wander, standing. Guide it by your body moves. Within a few minutes, you will learn how to manage it, and you will go for a friendly atmosphere while discovering the city; no effort required, no noise, and very respectful for the environment!

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THE ECO NEIGHBORHOOD OF BONNE GRENOBLE

1H30 TO 2 HOURS

In the city center, instead of an old military casern, this vast group of properties, shops and green spaces received in 2009, the French label for eco neighborhood. The Bonne neighborhood tour shows architecture based on a program for a sustainable city that highlights ecologic technologies. It notably allows 900 properties to reduce gas emissions.

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DISCOVERY OF STREET ART GRENOBLE

1H30 TO 2 HOURS

A tour in the city's streets and nocks where Works on frontages, bridges, doorways, mailboxes, pipes; are waiting for you. A tour that recalls for History and Street art's technics.

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THE IRON HAND OF XAVIER JOUVIN GRENOBLE

2 HOURS

In the neighborhood of Saint Laurent, the old glove manufacture made by Rey-Jouvin, tells the story of Grenoble's glove making from the 19th century until the sixties. Machines, engines and collections of gloves are shown. Notably "the iron hand", a cutting process created by Xavier Jouvin.

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ON THE STEPS OF CARTHUSIAN MONKS

Settled in « La Correrie », or else called the outbuilding from the monastery, it is at the heart of a small valley labelled "Forêt d'exception".

This museum testifies of the Carthusian monks' life around a true cloister and old cells. Then, go for a tour in Voiron, in order to visit the cellars that produce the liquor: "Chartreuse" and the elixir of life. A tasting ends the discovery.



TRIPS AROUND GRENOBLE

ON THE ROAD OF GRENOBLE'S WALNUTS

The museum 'Le Grand Séchoir' is settled in the old walnut drying cellar in Vinay, a place where 50 000 walnut trees, recounts the story of Grenoble walnut region and people that have been part of the international reputation of this fruit. Made with poesy, humor and precision.

SAINT-ANTOINE L'ABBAYE

Overlooked by its impressive abbatial church, the village of 'Saint-Antoine-l'Abbaye' is labelled as one of the Most Beautiful Villages of France. From the 11th century, it was the headquarter of Antonins knight hospitallers and one of the European most important place for pilgrimage. It retains numerous testimonies of architecture from its prestigious past.

CHORANCHES'S CAVES

From the entrance of the Caves, hidden at the heart of the cliffs of Presles between Pont-en-Royans and Villard de Lans, the show is magical: pure water lake, underground lakes and numerous concretions. Go through rooms decorated by see-through thin stalactites during a guided tour, getting all lighted up step by step.

MINI CRUISE ON THE LAKE OF 'MONTEYNARD' OR THE HIMALAYEN FOOTBRIGDES

Get yourself into the boat 'La Mira' for a guided cruise (1h30) on the artificial lake of 'Monteynard'. The captain brings you to the discovery of wild places that cannot be reached by foot of the Gorges: 'Drac' and 'Ebron'. Big free spaces, deep Gorges or more tighten ones where nature rules as master. For the sportiest: a pedestrian hike on top of the lake is possible thanks to the 2 himalayan footbrigdes as vertiginous as discreet.

LA SALETTE

Second place for the great pilgrimage in France after Lourdes, this basilica remains a landmark of the religious architecture in Isère area. Two children working as shepherds said that in 1946, they met 'La Belle Dame', crying. Possibility to visit the sanctuary and to take part during Mass.
